



## Clarence Victor Bowling

Clarence Victor Bowling, 85, of 2886 Westover Drive, Danville, VA, died Thursday, December 20, 2012 at Danville Regional Medical Center. He had been in declining health for three months and patient in the hospital for the past ten days.

Mr. Bowling was born in Pikeville, Kentucky on January 25, 1927, a son of the late Lon Bowling and the late Lesta Yeatts Bowling. He had been a resident of Danville, VA since 1948.
