Clark Ainslie Hodges, Jr. of Thomasville, NC died on Tuesday, November 22, 2016 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past 3 months.

Mr. Hodges was born in Museville, VA on May 25, 1927 son of the late Clark Ainslie Hodges, Sr. and the late Louise Hedrick Hodges. He graduated from Climax High School and went on to enlist in the United States Navy in WWII. Upon his return, he enrolled and graduated from Virginia Polytechnic Institute (Va Tech). He worked in the tobacco industry for many years employed by Brown and Williamson, Dibrell and lastly at MacTavish Industries, during this time in the industry he brought his expertise to Europe and Asia.
