Clyde Ray Hammack, 89, of Keeling, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, March 4, 2026 at his residence following two years of declining health.

Clyde was born in Danville on March 4, 1937 to the late William Hammack and Emma Towler Hammack.

On September 19, 1959, Clyde married Marilyn Hebert Hammack, who preceded him in death on December 3, 2024.

Clyde proudly served in the United States Air Force for 25 years, retiring with the rank of Master Sergeant. Following his military career, he came back to the Danville area and went on to work as a clerk for the United States Postal Service until his retirement. He was a member of Rock Springs United Methodist Church.

Clyde was a man of many interests and hobbies. He was part of the United Methodist Men, he enjoyed many trips with Sunshine Bus Tours, he enjoyed wood carving, collecting and repairing clocks and watches, and collecting Studebaker automobiles. He worked on and acted in many films and documentaries that were produced in Virginia. Above all, Clyde loved to help people, and did so in a variety of ways, including through his volunteer work

Clyde is survived by his daughter, Terry Hill (Danny); god-son, David Laws; grandchildren, Jeremy Hill and Courtney Quinn (Austin); great-grandchildren, Levi, Emmalyn, Brooks and Colsen; and two sisters, Peggy Welborn and Shelby Strange.
