Clyde Allen Searce, 80, of Cascade, VA, entered into his heavenly home on Thursday, October 6, 2022 after a decline in his health for past six months.

Clyde was born on January 7, 1942 in the Brosville community of Pittsylvania County, VA., a son of the late Claude Allen Searce and Maggie Parker Searce.

Clyde lived his entire life in Pittsylvania County, VA. He was a farmer for most of his adult life. In addition to farming, he worked for A.C. Furniture Company as a furniture maker, and he retired from Danville Memorial Gardens where he worked as a grounds keeper.
