Clyde Blane Stowe, of 1015 Kemper Road Ext, Danville, VA died on Monday, March 18, 2013 in Piney Forest Health Care Center where he had been a resident for three weeks.

Mr. Stowe was born in the Dry Fork Community of Pittsylvania County on December 20, 1933 a son to the late John Blane Stowe and Hattie Powell Stowe.
