March 9, 1914 - April 6, 2011

J. Craig Stowe, 97, of 148 North Ave, Danville, died Wednesday, April 06, 2011, at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in health for the past eight months. Mr. Stowe was born in Pittsylvania County, on March 9, 1914, the son of the late Henson Craig Stowe and Maude Green Stowe. He worked as a self employed salesman, and was a member of First Pentecostal Holiness Church, where he was active in many church functions. He served his country during WWII in the U. S. Navy. On October 6, 1934 he married his wife of 75 years, Virginia Foster Stowe, who died on February 23, 2010. He is survived by one brother, the Rev. Curtis W. Stowe, of Eden, NC; and a number of nieces and nephews. In addition to his wife he was predeceased by five sisters, Evelyn Stowe, Nellie S. Yeatts, Lavenia S. Yeatts, Lillie S. Yeatts, and Edna S. Gibson, and four brothers, Forrest Stowe, Harry Stowe, Lawrence Stowe, and Clyde Stowe. Funeral services will be held on Friday, April 8, 2011, at 2:00 P.M. from the First Pentecostal Holiness Church conducted by the Rev. Myron Bruce, the Rev. Joe Beck, and the Rev. Timothy Elliott. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park with military honors conducted by the American Legion Dan River Post #1097 Honor Guard. The family will receive friends on Friday one hour prior to the service at the church. Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel is serving the Stowe family.
