



## Curtis Eugene Chandler

January 28, 1931 - September 11, 2022

Curtis Eugene Chandler, 91, of Danville, Virginia, passed away on September 11, 2022.

Curtis was born in Rockingham County, North Carolina, on January 28, 1931, a son of the late Rufus Wilson Chandler and Princella Mae Stanley Chandler. He lived most of his life in Danville, Virginia where he worked for International Paper as a Grader. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War.
