



## Curtis Wells

November 11, 1936 - April 5, 2017

Weston Curtis Wells, 80, of 1448 Ringgold Road, Ringgold, VA died Wednesday, April 5, 2017 at Piney Forest Health and Rehabilitation Center after a decline in his health for the past year.

Curtis was born in Danville, VA on November 11, 1936, a son of the late Weston Wells and Florence Helen Wells Slayton. He lived his entire life in the Danville area and retired after forty years from Universal Leaf Tobacco Company. He was a member of North Main Baptist Church where he served on the kitchen staff and other church activities.

He was a veteran of the Vietnam War and a member of the American Legion Post 325. He was a member of the Improved Order of Redmen Poquoson Tribe # 124.

Curtis was married to the late Effie Smith Wells, who died on August 31, 2014.

In addition to his wife, he was predeceased by a daughter, Tammy Doss, who died on November 29, 2016.

Curtis is survived by two grandsons, Mark Doss, of Henrico, VA, and Joshua Doss, of Danville, VA; a sister, Penny Medlin, and husband Dennis, of Midlothian, VA; and an aunt, Eleanor Yancey, of Oxford, NC.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, April 8, 2017 at 11:00 AM from the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend Fred Unger officiating. Interment will follow the service in Highland Burial Park with military honors conducted by the American Legion Dan River Post 1097.

The family will receive friends on Friday, April 7, 2017 at the funeral home from 7:00 until 8:30 PM.
