



## Daniel Johnson

Daniel Gray Johnson, age 63 of 840 Jefferson Avenue, Waynesboro, Va., died Tuesday, April 13, 2010 after a decline in health for the past six months. Mr. Johnson was born on September 11, 1946 in Danville, a son of the late Henry Thomas Johnson and the late Dera Cooper Johnson. He had lived in Danville for many years and moved to Waynesboro in 2004. He graduated from Dan River High School in 1964.
