Danny Scism, 80, of Danville, VA, died Monday, July 1, 2024 at his residence after a decline in his health since February of 2023.

Danny was born in Danville, VA on November 23, 1943, a son of the late Jesse Austin Scism and Agnes Tillery Scism. He lived his entire life in Danville, VA and retired from Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company where worked in the Shipping Department.

Danny was a veteran, proudly serving in the U.S. Army in the Vietnam War.

Danny was an avid golfer and enjoyed shooting. He was a member of Sandy Shores Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon and on various other committees. He was a member of the Order of the Redmen, a life-time member of Southern Hills Golf Club.

On April 22, 1994 he was married to Vickie Coleman Scism, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, He is survived by a brother, Don Scism (Nancy) of Danville, VA; three nephews, Jacob Scism, Cedric Coleman, and Jeremy Coleman; and three nieces, Kristina Sekula, Angelina Coleman, and Amanda Anderson.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, July 6, 2024 at 2:00 P.M. at Sandy Shores Baptist Church with the Reverend Eric Clark and the Reverend Roy Jones officiating. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park.
