



## Darwyn Giles McCall

May 30, 1935 - September 7, 2022

Darwyn Giles McCall, 87, of Danville, VA, died Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at Forsyth Medical Center in Winston-Salem, NC after a decline in his health for the past six weeks.

Born in Franklin County, VA, on May 30, 1935, Darwyn was a son of the late John Meadow McCall and Nannie Elsie Law McCall. He lived most of his life in Danville, VA. He worked as a Draftsman at McCall Millwork Design where he was owner and operator. His work took him all over the east coast of the United States. Before working as a Draftsman, Darwyn worked at Danville Lumber Company and Manufacturing.

Darwyn was a member of Third Avenue Congregational Christian Church. He enjoyed reading, watching football, NASCAR racing, and movies with his son, and keeping in touch with his friends.

He was a veteran, proudly serving in the U.S. Air Force. He served as coordinator of the Air Force Reunions for Neah Bay, Washington.

On August 15, 1959 he was married to Carolyn Wilson McCall, she died on July 2, 2005.

Darwyn is survived by a son, Steven McCall (Joy) of High Point, NC. He was predeceased by a daughter, Kimberly Sue McCall; and five brothers and sisters.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, September 12, 2022 at 2:00 P.M. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park with Military Honors by the U.S. Air Force Honor Guard and the

American Legion Dan River Post 1097.
