David Jason Bullins, 80, of 1488 Ringgold Rd went home to be with the Lord on Friday, July 9, 2021 at his residence after a decline in health for the past year.

Born in Henry County, VA on February 28, 1941, he was the oldest son of the late Johnnie David Bullins and Sharlene Clark Bullins.

David retired from Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company. He coached in the Pittsylvania County Youth Football League for 38 years. For many years, he conducted a youth golf league at Ringgold Golf Club. He was a member of The Tabernacle.

On February 23, 1960 he married Connie McGuire Bullins, who survives of the residence.
