David Addison Hackney, 64, of 231 Inca Lane, Ringgold VA went home to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ after a long and courageous battle with cancer on Tuesday, September 20, 2011 at the VA Hospital in Durham, NC after being in declining health for several weeks. Mr. Hackney was born on October 26, 1946 in the Clover Community of Halifax County, VA a son of the late Ollie Addison Hackney and the late Leaone Watts Hackney. He spent most of his life in the Halifax and Pittsylvania County areas where he farmed for 15 years and had worked as an over the road truck driver for over 35 years until his retirement. He was a graduate of Halifax County High School, Class of 1964 and he served his country in the US Army and fought in Vietnam. He was a member of Sandy Creek Baptist Church. On June 28, 1985 he married Vickie Bledsoe Hackney, who survives of the residence. In addition to his wife Mr. Hackney is survived by three children, Brian A. Hackney and his wife Angie, of Lynchburg, VA, Dana H. Harris and her husband Stephen, of Semora, NC and Johnnie H. Wilmoth and her husband Steven of Ringgold, VA; one brother, Mark A.
