



David Riddle

April 1, 1922 - March 29, 2012

David Lloyd Riddle, a devoted husband and devoted Christian, died Thursday, March 29, 2012, three days before his ninetieth birthday.

Born on April 1, 1922 in Keeling, VA, he was the son of Lloyd David Riddle and Callie Motley Riddle. He graduated from Dan River High School and was a military Veteran of World War II.

He was married to Edna Anne Ingram Riddle, who died in 2002. He grew up in and was a long time member of Oak Grove Baptist Church. For the last 20 years he was a member of Community Baptist Church where he served as a devoted teacher and treasurer.
