David Lambert Solomon, Sr., 73, of 912 Barker Road, Milton, NC died on Monday, January 11, 2010 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for the past week. Mr. Solomon was born in Halifax County, VA on October 10, 1936 the son of the late Clyde Andrew Solomon and the late Mary Robertson Osborne Solomon. He spent most of his life in Semora, NC where he worked at Lorillard as a superintendent until his retirement. He served his country in the United States Army and fought in the Korean War. He was a member of Connally United Methodist Church in Milton, NC, where he had served as a lay leader and as superintendent of Sunday School. He was also a member of the Person County Senior High School and Bartlett-Yancey High School Booster Clubs. On June 5, 1959 Mr. Solomon married Blanch McCann Solomon who survives of the residence.
