Dennis Wayne Guill, 70, of 8168 Kentuck Road, Ringgold, VA, went home to be with his Lord on Sunday, March 31, 2024 at his residence.

Dennis was born in Danville, VA on August 21, 1953, a son of the late Willie J. "Rabbit" Guill, Jr. and Virl Campbell Guill. He spent all of his life in the Danville and Pittsylvania County areas, where he worked as a Breaker Applier Operator at Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company for 35 ½ years until his retirement. He was a member of Arbor Baptist Church in Sutherlin, VA.

In his spare time, he enjoyed hunting and was a member of the Oakdale Hunting Club. Dennis was well known in the community for his love of cooking stew and BBQ. He was also a lifetime member of Kentuck Fire Department, where he served on the Board of Directors. He was a member of The Improved Order of the Redmen Poquoson Tribe 124.

On August 17, 1973, he married the love of his life, Lorene Davis Guill.

In addition to his wife, Dennis is survived by his sons, Dennis Guill, II and his wife Christie of Reidsville, NC, and Jeffery Guill and his wife Ashley of Brosville, VA; five grandchildren, Autumn, Zack, Layla, Colton, and Sadie; his siblings, Mike Guill (Dianne), Robin Moore (Gary), and Laura Simon (Alan); and a number of nieces, nephews, and special friends.
