



Reverend Dewey Hubert Evans

May 28, 1929 - August 27, 2013

Reverend Dewey Hubert Evans, 84, of 10861 NC Highway 700, Pelham, NC died Tuesday, August 27, 2013 at Annie Penn Hospital in Reidsville, NC, after a decline in his health for the past 10 years. He had been a resident of Avante Nursing Home for almost four years.

Mr. Evans was born in Rockingham County, NC on May 28, 1929 a son of the late George Dewey Evans and Mary Elizabeth Evans. He lived his entire life in the Pelham community and retired as Minister of Shepherd Baptist Church in Pelham and as a farmer and carpenter. He was a member of Shady Oak Baptist Church on the Walters Mill Road and he loved the outdoors, hunting, fishing and playing music.

He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

On February 16, 1952 he married Irene M. Evans, who survives.
