Mrs. Dimple Jean Thompson White, age 74, of 6968 Fox Run Road, Linden, N.C., passed away at Womack Army Medical Center, Fort Bragg, N.C. on Saturday, June 12, 2010 after a decline in health for the past eight months. Mrs. White was born on February 5, 1936 in Danville, Va., a daughter of the late Clarence Thompson and the late Reva Dawson Thompson. She had lived her earlier life in Danville where she had attended Langston High School. She had lived the past thirty two years in the Fayetteville, N.C. area. She was a graduate of Fayetteville State University and had completed her degree in Intermediate Education and graduated Cum Lauda in 1984. She was employed as an Elementary Teacher with the Moore County Public Schools until her retirement in 1999 and had continued teaching in the Cumberland County Public Schools System. She was a member of Piney Grove Baptist Church in Fayetteville. She was a devoted military wife, married to Herbert Burk White (retire US Army) who predeceased her on April 21, 1979.
