Don Gary Shelton, 64, of Ringgold, passed away on Friday, April 11, 2025 at Chatham Health and Rehabilitation Center. He had been in declining health for several years.

Don was born on February 14, 1961 in Lynchburg, VA to the late Hinkel Shelton and Ella Sue Singleton Shelton.

Don spent most of his life in the Ringgold community. He retired from A. L. Morris Trucking where he worked as a truck driver. Don was of the Baptist faith.

Don was married to Linda Dawson Shelton, who survives.
