



## Donald Wilkerson

May 1, 1932 - March 15, 2012

Donald C. "Sonny" Wilkerson, 79, of 4300 Ringgold Church Road died on Thursday, March 15, 2012 at Lynchburg General Hospital after being in declining health since January.

Sonny was born in Pittsylvania County on May 1, 1932, a son of the late Walter Edward Wilkerson and the late Mary Lou Wiles Wilkerson. He spent most of his life in the Pittsylvania County area where he was a graduate of Dan River High School Class of 1950. He served in the US Army from 1953 to 1955 where he traveled to Germany. He worked for Norfolk Southern Railway for 47 years until his retirement as a Yard Master. He was also a part time employee of Wrenn-Yeatts Funeral Home.
