January 29, 1934 - February 9, 2017

Donovan “Don” Sager West, 83, of 121 Sprouse Road, Spartanburg, SC went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, February 8, 2017 in the Spartanburg Regional Hospice House after being in declining health for the past several months.

Donovan was born in Danville, VA on January 29, 1934 a son of the late Henry D. West and Alice Grissom West. He had lived all of his life in Danville and Spartanburg, SC. He was graduate of the former Schoolfield High School, Class of 1951 and a graduate of Virginia Tech., Class of 1955. Don had worked for Dan River Mills, Inc., Burlington Industries, Spring Mills, and Thomaston Mills, in Thomaston, GA where he had retired as director of Industrial Engineering. Don was past president of the Association of Textile Industrial Engineers, past chairman of the Textile Industrial Engineers Council, past president of the Abbeville, SC Jaycees and he was an avid golfer for over 60 years.

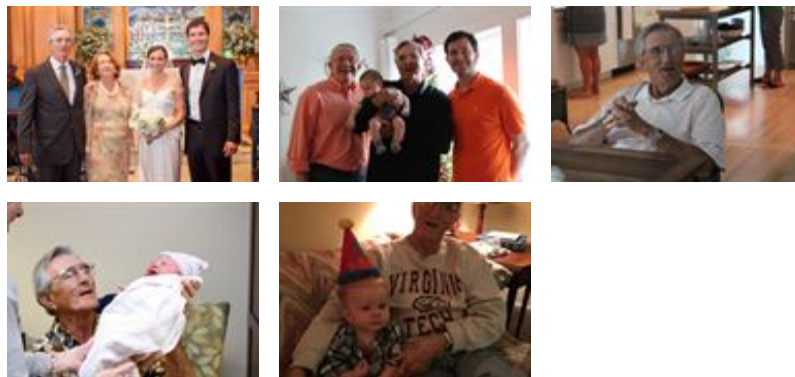
