Doris Dewar Basden, 88, of 141 Summit Road Danville, VA died Tuesday, March 13, 2012 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home. She had been in declining health since July. Mrs. Basden was born November 12, 1923 in New Bern, North Carolina the daughter of Henry B. Dewar and Lizzie Ashworth Dewar. She had lived in Danville since 1954 and prior to her retirement worked as an optician with American Optical. Mrs. Basden was a member of the Woodberry Hills Baptist Church, where she sang in the choir. She also was active with the Sweet Adelines. On June 16, 1950 she was married to C. Phillip Basden, he died April 7, 1994. Survivors include a son, Timothy L. "Tim" Basden and wife, Marilyn and a daughter, Beverly Gillespie and husband, Jimmy of Danville; three grandchildren, LeAnne Basden, Hart Gillespie and Blair Gillespie and two great-grandchildren, Riley Parsons and Liam Parsons. She was the last survivor of her generation. In addition to her husband and parents she was preceded in death by brothers, Carl Owen Dewar and Willis Jennings Dewar and a sister, Iva Dewar Terrell.
