



## Doris Triplett Earles

October 2, 1926 - September 29, 2014

Doris Elaine Triplett Earles, 87, of 4752 Stillmeadow Road, Axton, VA, went Home to be with her Lord on September 29, 2014. She passed away peacefully, surrounded by her family, at her residence where she had been declining in health for several weeks.

Mrs. Earles was born in Danville, VA, on October 2, 1926, the daughter of the late James O. Triplett and Minnie McNichols Triplett. She lived all of her life in the Axton and Sandy River communities.
