



## Doris Turner Holley

May 12, 1924 - February 11, 2014

Doris Turner Holley, 89, formerly of Blairs, VA, died Tuesday, February 11, 2014 at Abbingdon Place after being in declining health for the past two years.

Mrs. Holley was born in Danville, VA on May 12, 1924, a daughter of the late William A. Turner, Sr. and Mable Durham Turner. She lived her life in Danville, VA and had been a resident of Blairs, VA since 1972. She was a member of Third Avenue Congregational Christian Church where she was a former choir member.

Doris retired from Dan River Mills, Inc. after 38 years where she worked in the Sewing Room Department at the former Schoolfield Division.

On June 18, 1944 she married William C. "Buck" Holley, Jr. who died on January 23, 2012.
