Doris Jones Steele, 88, of 220 Arnett Blvd, danced and sang her way to her heavenly home on Sunday, August 7, 2016 at her residence after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mrs. Steele was born on January 23, 1928 in the Sheva Community of Pittsylvania County, VA, daughter of the late Alce Teach Jones and the late Lelia Wade Shelton Jones. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she worked at Dan River Mills as a weaver until her retirement in May of 1990. She was a member of Blessed Hope Baptist Church, where she loved to sing in the choir. She also loved to sing solos and write her own music.
