



## Dorothy Wyatt Moore

February 9, 1930 - February 1, 2014

Dorothy (Dot) Wyatt Moore, 83 of 117 Windsor Trail, Danville, VA died suddenly on Saturday, February 1, 2014 in Morehead Hospital in Eden, NC after being in declining health for the past one year.
