Dorothy Elizabeth Snead Wall, 95, of 444 Pinecrest Drive, Danville, VA passed away on Friday, August 20, 2021 at Sovah Health of Martinsville after a decline in her health for the past six months.

Mrs. Wall was born on February 13, 1926 in Purley, NC, a daughter of the late Bernard Thomas Snead and Mary Carmichael Snead. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA, and was a member of Vandola Baptist Church.

Mrs. Wall worked at Dan River Mills, Stoney Mill Elementary School, and 21 years with Roman Eagle Nursing Home as a dietician until the age of 80. She lived a long, full and independent life.
