



Douglas Butts

July 27, 1932 - March 26, 2009

Douglas Malloy Butts, Sr., 76, of 204 Summit Road died suddenly on March 26, 2009 at Danville Regional Medical Center but he had been in declining health for several months. Mr. Butts was born in Caswell County on July 27, 1932 to the late Earl Elwood Butts and the late Janie Bray Butts. He was a Master Sergeant in the United States Army serving in the Korean Conflict and a member of the Korean Warriors and Veterans Group. He spent most of his life in the Danville area where he worked for the former Dibrell Brothers Tobacco Company for 40 years as a vice president and held various other positions including an engineer and draftsman. He was an avid bowler for many years and a former member of the Danville Bowling League. Mr. Butts was of the Methodist faith. On December 25, 1959 he married Glendora Gerrald Butts who survives. In addition to his wife of the residence he is also survived by a daughter Pamela Butts Vaughan and husband Kenneth of Axton, VA; a son Douglas Malloy Butts, Jr. and wife Lisa of Danville, Va; one sister, Violet B. Terrell and husband Charles of Richmond, VA; three grandchildren, Tabitha Vaughan, Kayla Vaughan, and Emily Butts. Mr. Butts was predeceased in death by one sister Madeline B. Phillips and one brother Lloyd Butts. Funeral services will be conducted on Sunday, March 29, 2009 at 2:00 P.M. from the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel with the Reverend Kathy Gochenour officiating.
