



## Douglas Wayne Herndon

January 17, 1944 - May 21, 2026

Douglas Wayne Herndon, 82, of Dry Fork, VA, died Thursday, May 21, 2026 at his residence after battling cancer for more than six years.

Wayne was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on January 17, 1944, a son of the late John Harold Herndon and L.Z. Holley Herndon. He lived his life in Pittsylvania Co., VA and retired from Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company after more than 30 years of service where he worked as a relief operator on the No. 1 Tuber.

Wayne was a member of Faith Memorial Baptist Church. He enjoyed bird watching, especially purple martins and hummingbirds, and making bird houses and working with wood.

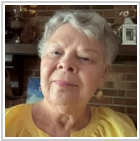
