Douglas Ray Lewis, 83, of 373 Dairy Lane, Sutherlin, VA, died on Thursday, December 13, 2018, at Sentara Halifax Regional Hospital, after a decline in health for the past three years.

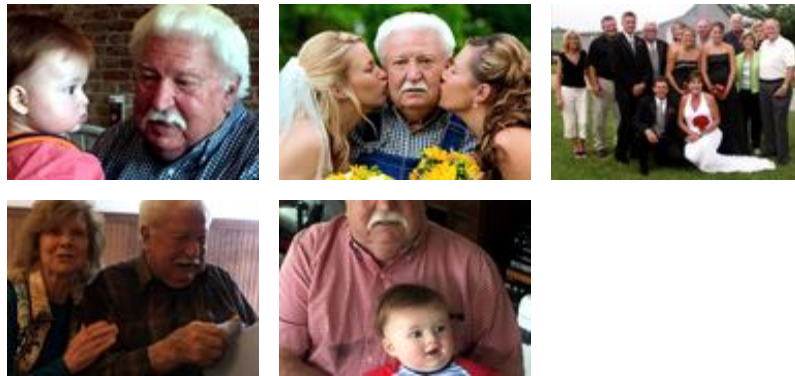
