Dustin Kurt Webster, 34, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, April 17, 2026, in Asheville, North Carolina.

Dustin was born in Danville, VA on February 26, 1992 to Janet and Curtis Webster. He graduated in 2010 from Bartlett Yancey High School in Yanceyville, North Carolina. He majored in Pharmaceutical Science at Campbell University, and attended graduate school at Wingate University, where he earned his Doctorate in Pharmacy in 2017. He made his home in Kernersville, North Carolina.

Dustin is survived by his wife, Margaret Webster; his children, Bennett and Anthony Webster; his parents, Curtis and Janet Webster; his sister, Ashley W. Payne (Josh); and his grandparents, Elsie Spicer, and Henry and Priscilla Webster.

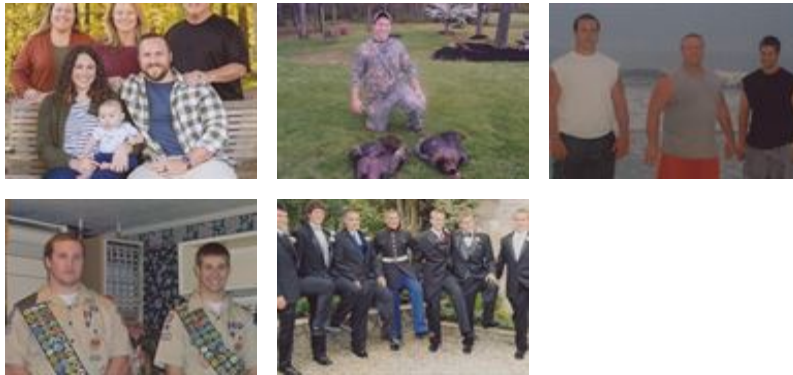
