Edith Davis Thompson, 90, formerly of 1929 Tunstall High Road, Danville, VA died on Friday, March 7, 2014 at Riverside Health and Rehab after a decline in health for several months.

Mrs. Thompson was born in Martinsville, VA on November 10, 1923 a daughter of the late Willie R. Davis and the late Mary Jane "Polly" Clark Davis. She spent all of her life in the Henry county and Pittsylvania country areas where she was a homemaker. She was a member of Dan River Primitive Church.

On November 5, 1947 she married the late Robert Clarence Thompson who died on April 2, 1999.
