Edith Lane Vicks, 95, of Danville, VA went home to be with her Lord on Saturday, June 29, 2024 at Sovah Health in Danville. She had been a resident at Roman Eagle Health and Rehab.

Edith was born in Danville, VA on April 20, 1929, a daughter of the late Arthur Robert Lane, Sr. and Hester Williams Lane. She spent all of her life in the Danville area where she was a homemaker. She was a member of the former Third Avenue Christian Church where she was a member of the Chapel Bible Class.

Edith was known by her family and many others as the "Hostess with the mostest!". Edith adored cultivating flowers and had a deep affection for life, especially for her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and even her great-great-grandchild.
