



Edith Stone Wingfield

May 27, 1946 - October 9, 2013

Edith Stone Wingfield, age 67, of 50 Waterfront Circle, Hampstead, N. Carolina, died Wednesday, October 9, 2013 unexpectedly at her home. She had been in declining health for the past ten years.

Born in Danville, VA on May 27, 1946, she was a daughter of the late Joseph Edward Stone and Anne Jones Stone. She lived her early years in Orange County, CA and was a graduate of South Gate High School, class of 1964. In 1969 Edith moved back Danville, VA and 2006 she moved to Hampstead, NC. Edith enjoyed painting, doing artwork and shooting pool with her family and friends. She attended Blessed Hope Baptist Church.

She was self-employed as a hair stylist for forty years.

On May 21, 1971 she married James Roy Wingfield, Jr. who survives.

In addition to her husband, of Chatham, VA, she is survived by three sons, Daniel Lee Wingfield, Sr., and his wife Sherry, of Dry Fork, VA, Dennis James Wingfield, and his wife Crystal, of Dry Fork, and David Edward Wingfield, and his wife Kristi, of Danville; a sister, Barbara Stone Evans, and her husband Gene, of Danville; a step-brother, Joseph Stone, and his wife Cathy, of Moyock, NC; four grandchildren, Daniel Lee Wingfield, Jr., Holly Price, Taylor Michelle Wingfield and Kiley Ann Wingfield; a grandson arriving in late December, and a special friend, Paul Gilbert, of Hampstead, NC.

She was preceded in death by a grandson, Blake Edward Wingfield.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, October 14, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. from the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend J. Brian Edwards

officiating. Interment will follow the service in Danville Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends on Sunday, October 13, 2013 at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel from 7:00 until 8:30 p.m. and other times they will be at the residence of Dennis and Crystal Wingfield, 121 Magnolia Acres Road, Dry Fork, VA.
