



Edna Williams Wallace

Edna Mayhew Williams Wallace, 95, formally of Chatham Court, Danville, VA died on Friday, February 16, 2018 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center after being in declining health for several months.

Mrs. Wallace was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on March 5, 1922, a daughter of the late Robert Motley Mayhew and the late Lorena Watlington Mayhew. She attended E.C. Glass High School in Lynchburg, VA. She spent most of her life in the Danville area where she first worked for the former Kinggoff's Jewelers in Danville for over 25 years then she went to work at the Gift Shop as a manager at Danville Regional Medical Center, until her retirement. She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church for over 50 years, but due to her hearing, impairment was unable to attend.
