



## Elouise Searce

April 17, 1921 - December 16, 2009

Elouise Potter Searce, 88, formerly of 195 Ficklin Avenue, died Wednesday, December 16, 2009 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in her health since August of 2003. Mrs. Searce was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on April 17, 1921, a daughter of the late James Willie Potter and the late Essie Allmond Potter. She had lived her life in Danville and Pittsylvania County and had retired from Dan River Mills, Inc. where she had worked in the weave room.
