December 5, 1921 - October 27, 2017

Elsie Prather Chaney, 95, of 106 Vine Circle, Danville, VA, died on Friday, October 27, 2017, at her residence, after a decline in health for the past six months.

Mrs. Chaney was born on December 5, 1921, in Danville, a daughter of the late Marion Prather and the late Hamey Dalton Prather. She lived most of her life in Halifax and Pittsylvania County where she was a homemaker raising her seven children. She was a member of the Central Boulevard Church of God. In her spare time, she was an avid doll collector and loved spending time with her family and friends.

On March 5, 1938, she married Alex C. Chaney, Jr., who died on October 20, 2000.
