



## Elsie Phillippe Whitfield

March 26, 1927 - April 27, 2021

Elsie Phillippe Whitfield, 94, of Ringgold, VA died Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at SOVAH Health in Danville after a decline in her health for the past year.

Elsie was born in Courtland, VA on March 26, 1927, a daughter of the late Ephraim Henry Phillippe, Jr. and Tressa Snavelly Phillippe. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA and she retired from the Public Health Department where she worked as a Registered Nurse.

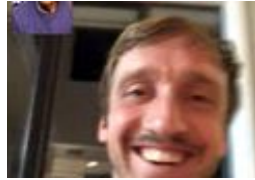
