Elton Carter Grant, 94, of 7781 U.S. Highway 29, died Friday, November 21, 2008 at Gretna Health Care. He had been in declining health for two weeks and a resident of Gretna Health Care for five days. Mr. Grant was born in Dry Fork, VA on January 20, 1914, the son of the late John Jim Grant and the late Maude Wallace Grant. He had lived most of his life in Blairs, VA and had retired as a farmer and from Perkins Foundry where he had worked as a molder.
