Elvin Rogers Shively, 79, of 122 Hampton Drive died, Thursday, May 21, 2015 at his residence after a brief decline in health.

Mr. Shively was born in Franklin County, VA on November 20, 1935, a son of the late Grover Milton Shively and Martha Ella Ingram Shively.
