Elwood Lindbergh Owen, 83, of 325 Wrenn Dr, Danville died Monday April 18, 2011 at Riverside Health & Rehab Center after a decline in health for the past year.

Mr. Owen was born on January 1, 1928, in Nathalie, VA the son of the late John Thornton Owen, Sr. and Emma Thornton Martin Owen.

He worked as a plant supervisor for Export Leaf Tobacco, and was a member of Shelton Memorial Presbyterian Church where he was an Elder. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict.
