February 14, 1950 - April 25, 2011

Mr. Eric George Obye of 329 Mowbray Arch, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Monday, April 25, 2011 at home surrounded by family after a 12 year fight with Progressive MS. He handled his battle with the disease with a grace and dignity that all around him found to be an inspiration. He maintained his sense of humor throughout and made everyone around him smile, even now. Eric was born on February 14, 1950 in Storm Lake, Iowa to Ken and Peggy Obye. He graduated from Virginia Tech with a BS Degree in Civil Engineering. On April 2, 1970, he married the love of his life Linda Carol Brooks, who survives. He lived in Pittsburgh, Pa. from 1973 to 2005, and raised his two children Keith and Alison there. He was a deeply devoted and loving father, husband, and grandfather. He was active with his family, as well as at Bower Hill Presbyterian Community Church where he was an Elder. His many passions included woodworking, photography and cycling. He was a General Manager of Services with Limbach Company and was a founding member of the Mt. Lebanon Cycling and Caffeine Club (formerly known as the Old Men in Tights). Eric enjoyed volunteering with Habitat for Humanity and participating in several long-distance cycle rides raising money for the National MS Society. Eric was determined not to be hospitalised as his disease progressed and this would not have been possible without the loving care and attention to detail of wife Linda, his primary caregiver .
