Ernest Reed Terry, 45, of 200 Swanson Ave, Danville died on Saturday, May 9, 2020 at Duke University after being in declining health for several months.

Ernest was born in Danville on May 31, 1974, son of Ernest Lesley Terry and Beverly Ann Bowling Terry. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Kroger for over twenty years before becoming an EMT. He then went on to work as an EMT for Virginia International Raceway until he retired due to his health. He was also the former fire chief of Mt Hermon Fire and Rescue for over 10 years.

Ernest never met a stranger, he loved being a EMT and lived to serve and help people. He truly had a servant's heart and had a dedication to put others before himself. He will be missed by all who knew him.

In addition to his parents of Danville, Ernest is survived by a sister, Lesley Ann Terry of Danville; maternal grandmother, Doris Bowling of Danville; special cousin/brother, Michael Bowling; and numerous, uncles, aunts, cousins and friends.
