



Eston "E.T." Ferguson

January 1, 1930 - September 21, 2025

Eston Thomas "E.T." Ferguson, 95, of 119 Westwood Drive, Danville, VA, died on Sunday, September 21, 2025 at his residence.

E.T. was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on January 1, 1930, a son of the late James Abner Ferguson and Janie Mae Lewis Ferguson. He spent all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Link Watson Corp as the Secretary/Treasurer until his retirement. He was a member of Sandy Shores Baptist Church, Tuscarora Country Club and the Elks Lodge.

On December 17, 1949 he married Mildred Wilson Ferguson who died on April 28, 2019.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was predeceased by his sister, Emma Horsley; and brothers, Aubrey V. Ferguson and Abner C. Ferguson.

E.T. is survived by his two daughters, Brenda Eastwood, and husband, Larry, Janet Powell, and husband, Gerald; a grandson, Rob Ferrell, and wife, Kristi; two great-grandchildren, Taylor and Evan.
