



## Ethel Garnell Harris Hobbs

Ethel Garnell Harris Hobbs, 74, of 1803 Mountain Hill Rd., Ringgold, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, October 15, 2017 at her residence after a decline in health for the past nine years.

Mrs. Hobbs was born April 15, 1943 in Danville a daughter of the late Rev. Lennie James Harris and the late Jessie Frances Marshall. She lived all of her life in the Mountain Hill Community of Pittsylvania County where she retired from Durham Hosiery Mills after 45 years of service. She was a charter member of the Non-Denominational Christian Tabernacle where she served as church treasurer and was very active in all church activities.
