Eugene Alton (Gene) Williams, 75, of 2122 NC Hwy 119 N, Leasburg, NC went home to be with the Lord on January 18, 2022 after being in declining health for three months. He was born in Horry County, SC on April 28, 1945, a son of the late Alton Dow Williams and Jewell Louise Fowler Williams.

Gene had lived most of his life in Caswell and Alamance Counties. He had retired from General Electric Corporation in Burlington, NC. 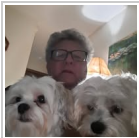

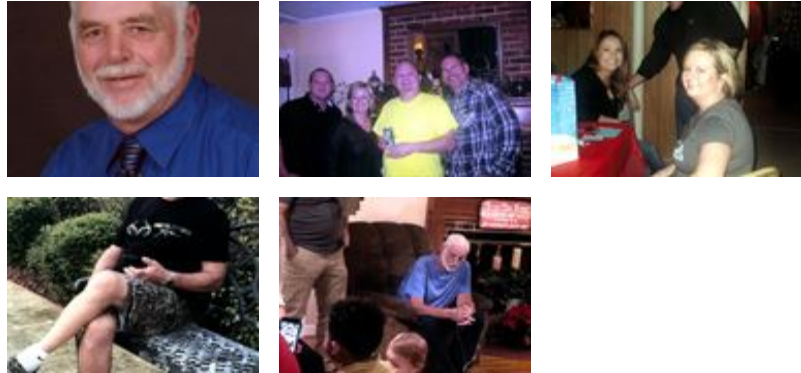
