Eva Mae Tramel Clark, 85, of the Vandola Community passed away on Saturday, April 2, 2016 after a decline in health for the past six months.

Mrs. Clark was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on November 17, 1930, a daughter of the late James Lester Tramel and the late Willie Florence Anderson.
