



## Eva Ferguson

January 19, 1910 - April 13, 2009

Eva Brown Ferguson, age 99, of 185 Olivers Lane died Monday, April 13, 2009 at her residence. She had been in declining health for the past 5 weeks. Mrs. Ferguson was born January 19, 1910 in Pittsylvania County the daughter of James Sidney Brown and Nannie Lewis Brown. She had lived in the Ringgold community until 1941 and then moved to Sutherlin. She was married in May 1930 to Acie Thomas Ferguson, who died May 22, 1995. She was also predeceased by 12 brothers and sisters and was the last survivor of her generation. Mrs. Ferguson worked in the cafeteria at Kentuck Elementary School for many years and also worked with her husband on the family farm. She has been a member of the Rocksprings United Methodist Church since 1922. Survivors include a son, Ray Maynard Ferguson of the home; two daughters, Thelma Cassada and her husband Vernell of Danville and Ruth Searce and her husband, Bobby of Ringgold; three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
