Mary Evelyn Hodnett Moore, age 92, of 840 Barker Road, Ringgold, VA, died Friday, July 31, 2015 at her residence after a decline in health for three years. Mrs. Moore was born on October 1, 1922 in Spring Garden, VA to the late Howard Clay Hodnett and Talitha Cumi Rowland Hodnett.

She was a homemaker and a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church where she served as a Sunday School teacher for 18 years. Mrs. Moore was also a member of the United Methodist Women's Association and served as a trustee with the church. On April 14, 1940, she married Robert W. Moore, Jr. who survives.
