



## Evelyn Walker

August 12, 1915 - February 17, 2019

Evelyn Farmer Hooper Walker, 103, went home to be with the Lord on February 17, 2019 at Roxboro Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center after several years of declining health.

Evelyn was a native of Caswell County born in Blanch, N.C. on August 12, 1915. She was the daughter of the late Georgianna Hodges Farmer and John Edward Farmer. Evelyn spent her life in Caswell and Person County, N.C. She was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School and Appalachian State University. 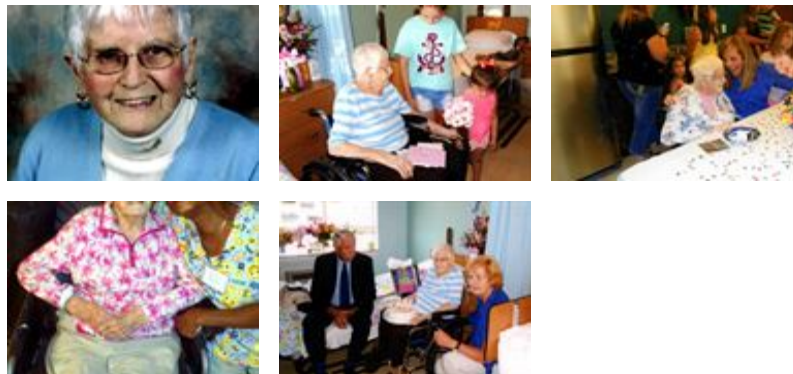
